Things That Are OK to Share

- Hobbies, games, movies, and music you like
- School subjects (not the school name)
- Activities that don't show where you live or where you are

Things That Are NOT OK to Share

- Your home address or school name
- When your family is not home or traveling
- Photos inside your house
- What supplies or equipment your family has

Online Safety Rules

- Don't share your location
- Don't accept friend requests from strangers
- Don't click strange links or downloads
- Don't send photos to people you don't know

Rule: If you wouldn't tell a stranger, don't post it.
