FLASH — IRAN WAR DAY 26 — POST-1200 EDT UPDATE

FLASH-001A	Iran War Day 26 — Iranian Attack on Saudi Abqaiq / Ras Tanura Oil Complex
WHAT	Iranian forces launched a coordinated drone and ballistic missile attack directly targeting Saudi Arabia's Abqaiq oil processing facility and Ras Tanura export terminal in the Eastern Province.
WHERE	Saudi Arabia Eastern Province — Abqaiq oil processing facility and Ras Tanura crude export terminal; both are components of the world's largest oil processing and export infrastructure.
WHEN	Attack sequence occurred within an 11-hour window today, 26 March 2026, confirmed post-1200 EDT; Saudi MoD announced intercepts this afternoon.
WHO	IRGC (attacker — drones and ballistic missile); Saudi Armed Forces (defender — claimed intercept of 32+ drones and one ballistic missile).
SO WHAT	Abqaiq and Ras Tanura collectively process approximately 7% of global oil supply; a direct Iranian attack on this complex — even one that was intercepted — is a qualitative escalation beyond any target struck to date and drove Brent crude above \$107/bbl from the morning DTR baseline of ~\$100.

CONFIDENCE	HIGH — Saudi MoD intercept claim is Tier 1; physical damage assessment at Abqaiq/Ras Tanura is PENDING independent confirmation and is the key intelligence gap.

FLASH-001B	Iran War Day 26 — IDF Strikes Isfahan; IRGC Navy Commander Killed
WHAT	Israel struck Iranian military infrastructure in Isfahan, dropping approximately 70 bombs on ballistic missile launch, storage, and air defense sites in western Iran; the IDF separately confirmed the killing of the head of the IRGC Navy.
WHERE	Isfahan and western Iran (Israeli airstrikes on missile and air defense infrastructure); Lebanon — Hajir area (IRGC Navy Commander killed in separate IDF strike); central Israel — Kafr Qasim, Ganei Tikva, Tel Aviv (Iranian ballistic missile response).

WHEN	Strikes and confirmed kill announced by IDF today, 26 March 2026, post-1200 EDT; Iran responded with two rounds of ballistic missiles on central Israel the same afternoon.
WHO	IDF (20 strike sorties, ~70 bombs, Isfahan and western Iran; IRGC Navy Commander kill); IRGC (ballistic missile response, two rounds, central Israel); Israeli Home Front Command (shelter activations Jerusalem, Tel Aviv).
SO WHAT	A named IRGC Navy Commander kill and simultaneous precision strikes on missile infrastructure in Isfahan represent a significant operational escalation; Iranian missile response on central Israel confirms the exchange pattern is intensifying, not winding down despite the Trump deadline extension.

CONFIDENCE	HIGH — IDF strikes and IRGC Navy Commander kill are Tier 1 confirmed; Iranian missile response on central Israel multi-source corroborated.

FLASH-001C	Iran War Day 26 — Trump Extends Hormuz Power-Plant Strike Deadline to 6 April
WHAT	President Trump extended his deadline for Iran to reopen the Strait of Hormuz from approximately 28 March to 6 April 2026, holding off on threatened strikes against Iranian power plants and citing active back-channel communications.
WHERE	Washington DC (US policy announcement); Islamabad, Pakistan (Pakistani interior minister held secret meeting with Iranian ambassador — back-channel confirmed); Strait of Hormuz (remains closed).
WHEN	Deadline extension announced today, 26 March 2026; new deadline is 6 April 2026.
WHO	Trump administration (deadline extension); Pakistan (mediator — interior minister meeting confirmed); Iran (back-channel acknowledged by Iranian FM as message exchange only, not negotiation); GCC Secretary-General (stated Iran already charging passage fees in violation of international law).
SO WHAT	The morning DTR assessed the power-plant pause expiring ~28 March; the new April 6 deadline materially changes the operational calendar and is the primary diplomatic development of the afternoon, though Iran's simultaneous missile strikes on Israel and attack on Saudi oil infrastructure are inconsistent with a de-escalatory posture.
