COMPETITIVE POSITIONING

Platforms like Everbridge, Rave Mobile Safety, and OnSolve provide notification and alerting — they tell you something happened and push a message. They do not provide threat analytics and do not provide recommended actions.

The DTR fills the upstream analytical layer:

- ▶ Notification platforms: "A storm is approaching" → DTR: "Here is the risk score, who is affected, what to do, and what happens next"
- ▶ News aggregators: "Here are today's headlines" → DTR: "Here are the scored, sourced, graded threats with confidence ratings and alternative assessments"
- ▶ Social media monitoring: "People are talking about X" → DTR: "X is confirmed/unconfirmed, here is the Tier 1 source basis, here is the analyst assessment"
