BOTTOM LINE UP FRONT

BLUF — 18 MAY 2026 (Monday weekend rollup)

STATUS: PREP-CON 3 ELEVATED, Trend STABLE-DETERIORATING. Op Epic Fury Day 80; US naval blockade of Iran Day 36; Lebanon ceasefire Day 33 (extended 45 days on 15-MAY through ~29-JUN — porous, not collapsed). SWX-CON stepped down from 3 to 2; [SWPC](#) G1 watch fires 18-19 MAY.

URGENT — RENEWED IRAN STRIKES: [NYT](#) reports 17-MAY that US and Israel are conducting “intensive preparations” for renewed strikes against Iran “as early as next week,” largest US-Israel military buildup since the Iran-side CF. Pentagon examining renewal of the halted operation; corroborated by Israel National News + [Times of Israel](#). This is the cycle’s highest-impact new driver — see KJ-5 and GEO-002. MIC second-order chain: per [CSIS](#), Patriot + THAAD interceptor stockpiles already ~50% expended; renewed sustained-intercept ops reach critical-low in 7-14 days.

URGENT — CYBER: Three new cyber items this rollup: (1) Microsoft Exchange CVE-2026-42897 XSS spoofing added to KEV 15-MAY (FCEB due 29-MAY); (2) NGINX CVE-2026-42945 (CVSS 9.2) actively exploited within days of disclosure; (3) Grafana GitHub token compromise + extortion 17-MAY.

LEBANON: Ceasefire extended 45 days on 15-MAY (third Washington round). 657 Lebanese killed since CF began per Lebanese Health Ministry; 18 more killed 16-17 MAY post-extension; 20th IDF KIA Saturday 16-MAY in southern Lebanon. US continues to permit targeted IDF action against assessed Hezbollah threats. 4th Washington round 2-3 JUN; separate security track 29-MAY at Pentagon (Simon Karam lead).

IRAN-HORMUZ: Strait remains effectively closed. **Trump-Xi Beijing summit concluded 15-MAY** with no joint statement; vague Iran/Hormuz commitment from Xi; Trump’s 200-Boeing-aircraft claim unconfirmed by Beijing (no formal PRC announcement). Pakistan-mediated US-Iran track continues; Iranian 30-day proposal (lift blockade + reparations + new Hormuz governance, nuclear deferred) still on the table.

RUSSIA-CHINA AXIS: Kremlin announced 16-MAY that Putin will travel to Beijing 19-20 MAY for two-day state visit with Xi, scheduled to coincide with the 25th anniversary of the 2001 Sino-Russian Treaty of Friendship. Joint declaration planned; Lavrov said 16-MAY that Moscow’s ties with Beijing are “deeper and

stronger than traditional political and military alliances.” Watch readout for Iran-positive language or new anti-US security clauses.

SEVERE WX: [SPC](#) Day 1 MODERATE RISK central/NE Kansas → SE Nebraska (strong-to-intense tornadoes, 2-4+ inch hail) + Enhanced/Slight surrounding IA/NW MO/southern Plains; EXTREME fire weather Southern High Plains 18-19 MAY. Multi-day severe + flash-flood pattern 18-22 MAY peaking mid-week. [NWR](#) coverage gaps inside threat zone: KS Ulysses, NM triple-gap, IL Hillsboro, MN Gunflint Lake, TX Rio Grande City.

SPACE WX: [SWPC](#) G1 (Minor) watch 18-19 MAY on glancing-blow CME. Greatest expected Kp 5.33 in 03-06 UTC 19-MAY window. HF mostly favorable; brief fades possible at higher latitudes.

3. Pre-position household shelter + power-out plans across KS/OK/TX/NE/IA/MO/AR/WI for 18-22 MAY. See [\[WX-001\]](#).
4. NWR-gap households: TWO-of-THREE non-NWR alert paths (WEA + [NWS](#) app + commercial broadcast).

KEY JUDGMENTS

Five key judgments. Confidence bands per ICD 203 estimative language. Full evidence base lives in the linked FLASH entry.

KJ-1: Lebanon ceasefire holds porously through 29-JUN.

CONFIDENCE: HIGH — Third successful 45-day extension on 15-MAY despite continued IDF strikes (18 Lebanese killed 16-17 MAY) and Hezbollah rocket fire. Tripwire for collapse: high-mass IDF Beirut Dahieh strike + Hezbollah ≥50-launch barrage same week. Full analysis: [\[GEO-CF-LBN\]](#).

KJ-2: Strait of Hormuz remains effectively closed through Q2 2026.

CONFIDENCE: MODERATE — Trump-Xi Beijing summit produced no operational reopening mechanism; Boeing 200-aircraft claim vague and unconfirmed. Iranian 30-day proposal on the table but US rejects nuclear deferral. Full analysis: [\[GEO-001\]](#).

KJ-3: Multi-day severe + flash-flood pattern produces ≥10 county-EOC activations 18-22 MAY.

CONFIDENCE: HIGH — Amplified upper pattern + Rockies trough drives repeated severe and flash-flood rounds. [NWR](#) coverage gaps at KS Ulysses, NM triple-gap, IL Hillsboro, MN Gunflint Lake, TX Rio Grande City sit inside the threat footprint. Full analysis: [\[WX-001\]](#).

KJ-4: Andes hantavirus second-generation transmission very unlikely through 21-JUN.

CONFIDENCE: HIGH — Day 5 post-index case with zero second-generation cases at [UNMC](#) biocontainment. Full analysis: [\[HLTH-001\]](#).

KJ-5: Renewed US-Israel kinetic operation against Iran likely within 14 days.

CONFIDENCE: MODERATE — [NYT](#) 17-MAY reports US-Israel “intensive preparations” for renewed strikes “as early as next week,” described as the largest military buildup since the Iran-side CF. **MIC second-order chain:** per [CSIS](#), US Patriot + THAAD interceptor stockpiles already ~50% expended post-Op Epic Fury; renewed sustained-intercept operations reach critical-low in 7-14 days, with potential Indo-Pacific exposure if [CENTCOM](#) pulls THAAD from Korea. Pentagon FY27 munitions request ~\$70B (3x current). Defense-sector ETF (ITA) +35% June 2025 → March 2026. Full analysis: [\[GEO-002\]](#).

US-Israel preparing renewed strikes on Iran; largest buildup since CF.

Current state: [NYT](#) 17-MAY: US and Israel in “intensive preparations” for renewed strikes against Iran “as early as next week,” described as the largest US-Israel military buildup since the Iran-side CF. Pentagon examining renewal of halted operation. Trump returned from China 15-MAY “facing significant decisions regarding Iran.” Corroborated by [Israel National News](#) and [Times of Israel](#).

Downstream: If renewed strike order issued: Hormuz transit collapses further; Brent +\$10-15/bbl on confirmation; Iranian Houthi-proxy activation likely within 48h; US/EU airspace advisories almost certain; Lebanon CF follow-on collapse risk elevates per KJ-1 tripwire.

Current state: [SPC](#) Day 1 MODERATE RISK central/NE Kansas → SE Nebraska (strong-to-intense tornadoes, 2-4+ inch hail) + Enhanced/Slight surrounding IA/NW MO/southern Plains; EXTREME fire weather (RH < 15%, wind 30-40mph) Southern High Plains 18-19 MAY; [WPC](#) ERO Day 2 SLIGHT with 3-5 inch localized QPF. [NWR](#) coverage gaps inside threat zone: KS Ulysses (DDC), NM triple-gap (Roswell/Carlsbad/Artesia, EXTREME fire-wx), IL Hillsboro (LSX), MN Gunflint Lake (DLH), TX Rio Grande City (BRO).

Downstream: Pre-position shelter + power-out plans across KS/OK/TX/NE/IA/MO/AR/WI. NWR-gap households verify two-of-three non-NWR alert paths.

NGINX CVE-2026-42945 heap overflow CVSS 9.2 actively exploited within days of disclosure.

[CYB-010 | NEW THIS CYCLE | Score 25]

Current state: VulnCheck observed active exploitation 17-MAY. Affects NGINX Plus + Open versions 0.6.27 → 1.30.0. Crash even with ASLR; RCE on ASLR-disabled hosts.

Downstream: Patch fleet-wide; verify kernel.randomize_va_space=2; consider WAF rules blocking crafted HTTP requests against rewrite-module endpoints.

Current state: FCEB deadline 17-MAY passed; at least 10 parallel clusters still exploiting. XenShell + Godzilla web shells; Cluster 10 deploys credential stealer targeting AWS vManage credentials.

Downstream: Audit patch status across all in-scope assets; re-baseline detections for XenShell + Godzilla; re-issue JWT signing keys.

Downstream: Energy prices stable but at risk-on for any escalation. Watch list: fourth Islamabad round date; Iranian counter-proposal language changes; sea-mine emplacement.

Downstream: Verify patch deployment status across FCEB and critical-infrastructure fleets before EOD Wednesday; non-FCEB private-sector operators close the window this week.

Trump claims (not confirmed by Beijing): 200 Boeing aircraft purchase; rare-earth resolution; one-year trade extension. Iran: vague commitment; Taiwan: "no commitment either way"; DPRK: denuclearization-via-talks.

Downstream: Watch list 18-25 MAY: Boeing confirmation; Beijing demarche to Tehran; UN posture on US blockade enforcement.

Current state: Single GitHub access token compromised; codebase downloaded; extortion attempt. Grafana states no customer data accessed and no production-system impact.

Downstream: Add Grafana to enhanced-vigilance watch for next 6 months; expect derivative CVE flow Q3 2026.

Andes hantavirus US-side surveillance Day 5 — zero second-generation cases.

[HLTH-001 | STABLE | Score 20]

Current state: Day 5 post-index case; [UNMC](#) biocontainment posture verified; [CDC](#) + NE-DHHS active surveillance of contact cohort; Hondius-cohort travel-history follow-up ongoing.

Downstream: No operational practitioner action this stage; surveillance window through 21-JUN.

Downstream: Ag-sector operators pre-position emergency-evac plans for livestock and on-farm fuel storage.

PREP-CON + COMCON ASSESSMENT — TOP-5 ACTION ITEMS

Current PREP-CON: 3 ELEVATED — Trend STABLE-DETERIORATING

Drivers: Op Epic Fury Day 80; US naval blockade Day 36; Lebanon CF extended (porous); multi-day severe-weather corridor; three new cyber items in 72-hour rollup; renewed US-Israel strike preparation per [NYT](#) 17-MAY.

Why PREP-CON 3 ELEVATED this cycle

Four concurrent drivers each carry household-level decision pressure inside the 0-72h window: **(1)** multi-day severe + flash-flood corridor 18-22 MAY across central US with [NWR](#) coverage gaps inside the threat footprint; **(2)** three actively-exploited or imminently-exploitable cyber items affecting household and small-business infrastructure (NGINX, Exchange, [Cisco](#) SD-WAN); **(3)** renewed US-Israel kinetic preparation against Iran with second-order pump-price and travel-disruption risk; **(4)** late-season WY/CO snow anomaly compounding mountain-corridor travel risk against ongoing exceptional drought. **Movement criteria:** PREP-CON moves to 2 SIGNIFICANT if the renewed Iran-strike order is observed or if Lebanon CF formally collapses; PREP-CON moves to 4 GUARDED only if cyber + severe-wx + Iran-prep windows all close benignly within 7 days.

Current COMCON: 4 PARTIALLY DEGRADED (CONUS) — Trend STABLE

Drivers: 33 [NOAA Weather Radio](#) transmitters affected across 14 states (14 OUT OF SERVICE plus 19 DEGRADED). The Alaska 17-site cluster dominates the total count but sits outside the CONUS severe-weather corridor. Seven CONUS critical gaps sit inside this week's severe-weather threat footprint where alerting is most consequential: **KS Ulysses WXN-81** (Dodge City CWA, inside SW Kansas dry-microburst zone); **NM triple-gap** Roswell WWG-36 + Carlsbad WWF-37 + Artesia WXN-24 (Albuquerque + Midland/Odessa CWAs, all inside the EXTREME fire-weather corridor 18-19 MAY); **IL Hillsboro KXI-79** (St. Louis CWA, eastern flank of Day 2 ERO); **MN Gunflint Lake KXI-45** (Duluth CWA, Day 2 Upper Midwest threat); **TX Rio Grande City WNG-601** (Brownsville/RGV CWA, Day 4-5 heavy-rain corridor edge).

Why this matters: the outage profile has not materially worsened in 72 hours, but the consequence multiplier is elevated this cycle because of the active severe-weather overlay. Households inside the seven CONUS critical-gap CWAs should treat themselves as operating on TWO-of-THREE non-NWR alert paths

through the threat window: Wireless Emergency Alerts (verify enabled in phone settings) plus the [NWS mobile app](#) plus a confirmed commercial broadcast TV or radio backup.

Movement criteria: COMCON moves to 5 SIGNIFICANTLY DEGRADED if any of the seven CONUS critical-gap sites take on a confirmed cellular-tower or commercial-broadcast outage in the same county (creating a triple-failure on alerting paths for the affected population). COMCON moves to 3 NOMINAL-DEGRADED only when the active severe-weather threat overlay clears AND at least four of the seven CONUS critical-gap transmitters return to service.

Top-5 actions for this cycle

1. Patch NGINX CVE-2026-42945 fleet-wide and verify ASLR posture by EOD Monday.
2. Enable Microsoft Exchange EEMS within 48 hours; prepare for permanent patch deployment.
3. Pre-position household shelter and power-out plans across KS/OK/TX/NE/IA/MO/AR/WI for 18-22 MAY threat window.
4. NWR-coverage-gap households verify two-of-three non-NWR alert paths through the threat window.
5. Audit [Cisco](#) SD-WAN patch status; re-baseline detections for XenShell + Godzilla web shells.
