Analyst Assessment

CEASEFIRE STATUS: The April 7-8 ceasefire is operationally non-functional. Both sides have now exchanged direct strikes twice in 48 hours. The diplomatic framing no longer describes operational reality. The structure that produced 57 days of managed friction has broken down.

Summary	The IAEA released its June 4 quarterly report on Iran safeguards, the first since the agency stopped verification activities on 28-FEB-2026. The report describes an irreversible loss of continuity of knowledge over Iranian nuclear material. FDD/ISIS published a detailed analysis of the report on 09-JUN, confirming near-total ongoing monitoring loss and noting the report provides no information on candidate sites where 440.9 kg of 60%-enriched HEU -- enough fissile material for multiple nuclear weapons if further enriched to 90%+ -- may be stored or entombed. The Fordow underground facility and Isfahan tunnel complex are both assessed as largely intact based on open-source satellite analysis. Iran has offered to down-blend HEU but not
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	historical AEOI behavior under inspection gaps is to accelerate production; underground facilities were specifically designed for operational continuity under attack conditions.

Analyst Assessment	SUSTAINED CAMPAIGN: The Iranian ICS/OT campaign has been active since at least the 28-FEB 2026 Op Epic Fury launch. It represents a deliberate strategic choice to impose costs on the US at the infrastructure level while conventional military engagement continues in the Middle East. The campaign is calibrated to stay below the threshold for direct military retaliation. CISA CAPACITY GAP: The simultaneous reduction of CISA's capacity to support sector coordination through staffing cuts creates a structural vulnerability: the agency responsible for coordinating critical infrastructure cyber defense has reduced capability precisely when the threat is most elevated. 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	Minister Michelle O'Neill condemned the violence. The victim's own family issued a statement calling for the riots to stop. Senior political figures in Britain including Northern Ireland Secretary Hilary Benn praised members of the public who intervened during the knife attack, but the video of the attack has been spread by far-right social media accounts including Musk, Farage, and Tommy Robinson. No direct connection between the ICA (Irish Citizen Army, new far-right group) and the current riots has been confirmed; the ICA is a background-level organisational presence within the broader Irish far-right ecosystem currently under Garda monitoring.
Analyst Assessment	CHANGE FROM PRIOR: De-escalation. PSNI reports 16 arrested this week and 12 officers injured Wednesday; water cannon and attenuating energy projectiles

✓ **Supporting Evidence:** PSNI has deployed riot units; Government of UK and NI are making statements; community response in prior cycles was effective; the loyalist-nationalist joint framing may not hold if nationalist communities decline to participate.

✗ **Ruling-Out Evidence:** Today's City Hall rally has not occurred yet; joint loyalist-nationalist framing, if it holds, would be a structural escalation beyond prior cycles.

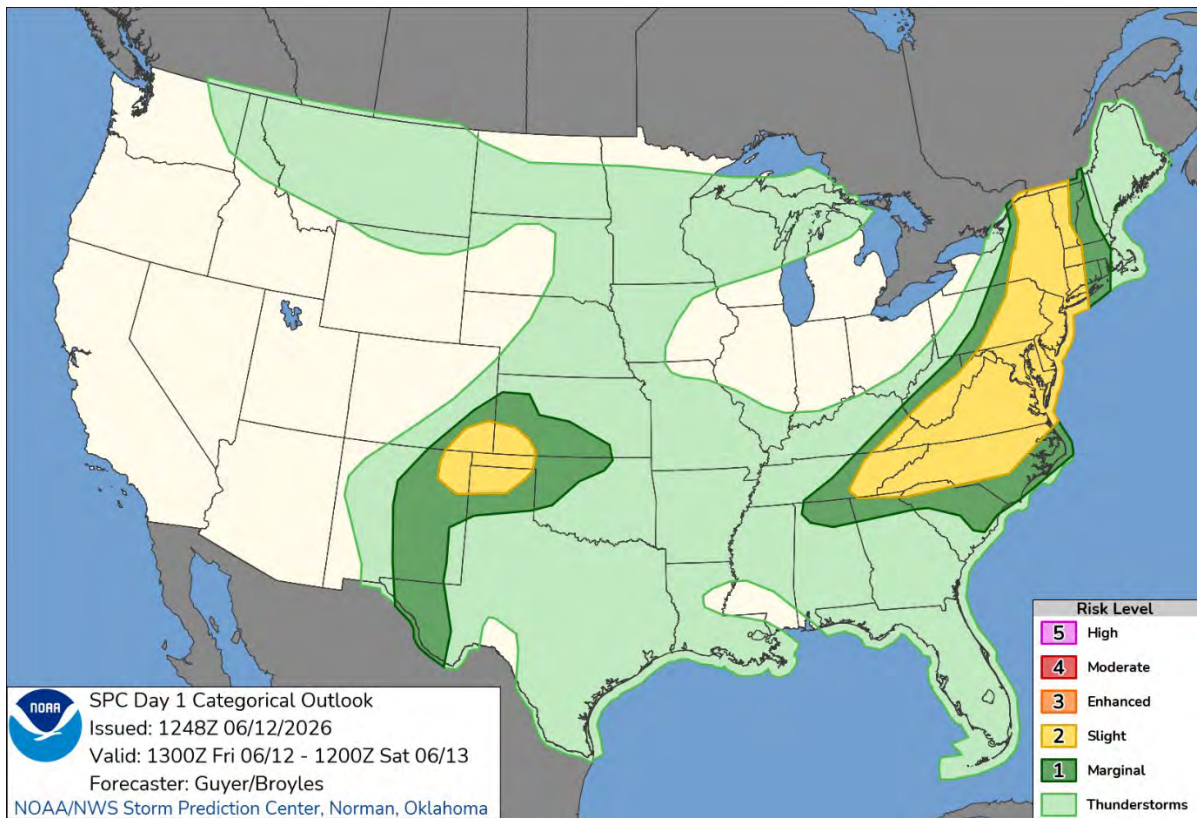

NWR COMPOUND NOTE	Today's primary Slight Risk over the Appalachians/Mid-Atlantic/Northeast has limited overlap with the current NWR outage roster -- the bulk of the 33 OOS/DEGRADED transmitters (NOAA pull 12-JUN 1043Z) are in Alaska, the Gulf/Southwest and the upper Midwest, not the Northeast threat zone. In the secondary High Plains risk area, note NM Roswell (WWG36), NM Artesia (WXN24) and NM Carlsbad (WWF37) are OUT OF SERVICE, reducing NWR coverage across the eastern New Mexico portion of the severe area. 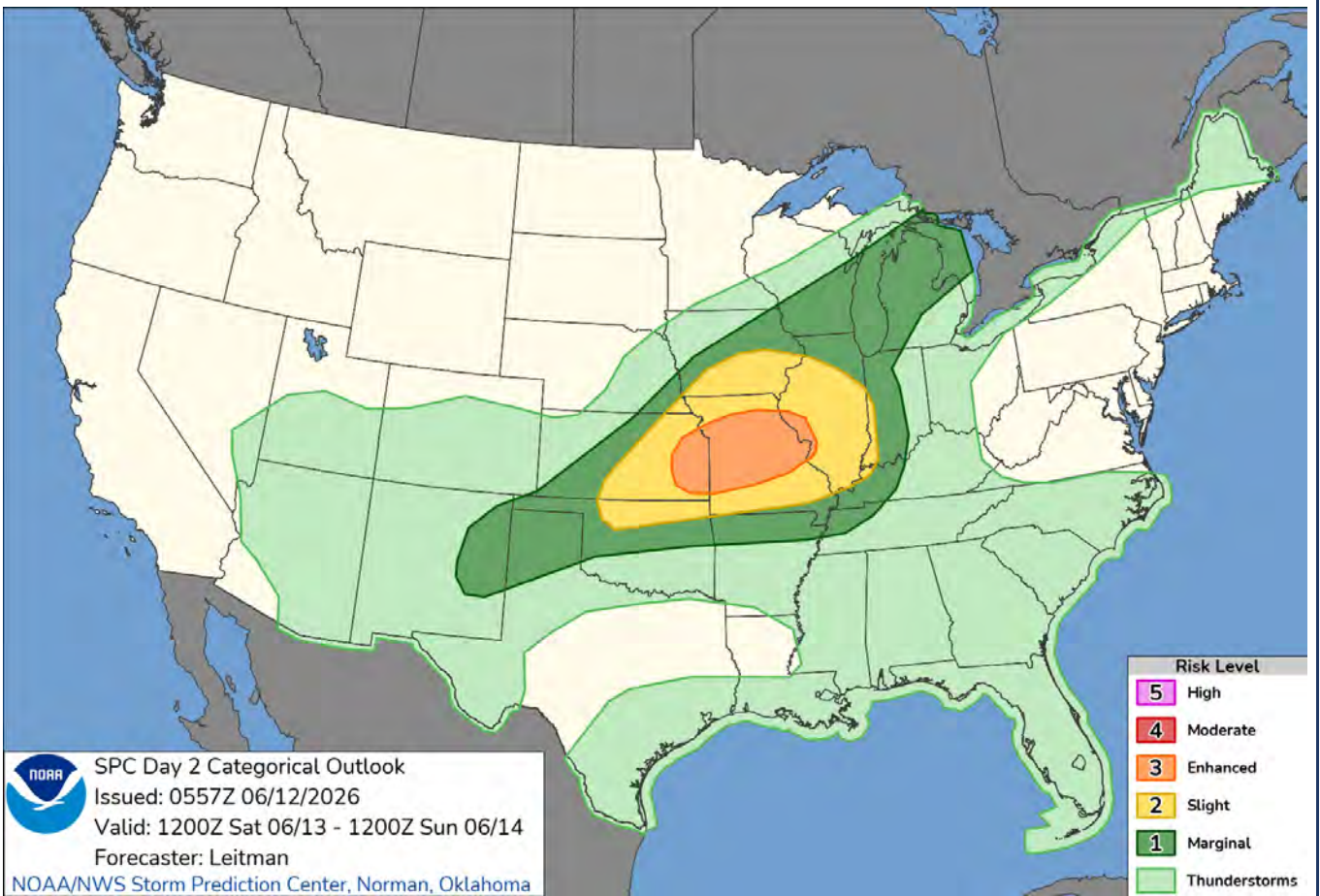

Operationally this matters for two compounding reasons: HF propagation fade at higher latitudes degrades the EMCOMM fallback bearer during an active severe-weather period (WX-001), and reduced GNSS accuracy stacks on the deliberate GPS jamming already present in the Strait of Hormuz (see MAR-001 / COMCON 4). A NOAA geomagnetic storm watch of G2 or greater is itself a PREP-CON 4 indicator trigger under SOP 0.129.
Summary	NOAA SWPC issued a G3 (Strong) geomagnetic storm watch for 09-J
