BLUF - 01 JUN 2026 | Executive Brief | 72h Monday over-weekend rollup

STATUS: [PREP-CON 3](#) INCIDENT PROBABLE (Brown Sky), Trend STABLE. Monday over-weekend standard 24h cycle. US naval blockade of Iran Day 51; Lebanon CF extension ended 30-MAY with no confirmed renewal. [WX-CON 2 SLGT](#) dual-area: SE corridor MCS + Central High Plains supercells today; [SWX-CON 1 Minor](#) on a brief K4 geomagnetic event 30-MAY, resolved; conditions quiet 01-JUN.

URGENT - IRAN: Tentative 60-day MoU not formally sigvolatile: talks suspended 01-JUN then reportedly restored; Trump states deal within one week. Brent \$94.58/bbl (volatile: surged to \$96 on 01-JUN suspension news, pared on Lebanon ceasefire); AAA regular \$4.290/gal (down from \$4.391 last week, +37.5% year-over-year). Hormuz: effectively closed (4 transits vs 95/day pre-crisis per IMF PortWatch 24-MAY). CENTCOM providing navigational guidance. MARAD 2026-004 active through 09-SEP. Even if signed, physical normalization is slow: mines must clear, fields take months to restart, tanker backlog persists. Blockade Day 51.

PUBLIC HEALTH - EBOLA: WHO Ebola PHEIC (Bundibugyo strain; no approved vaccine or specific treatment) remains in force. Updated figures per WHO/ECDC as of 01-JUN: DRC 282 confirmed (42 deaths) + 220 suspected; Uganda 9 confirmed (1 death); 291 confirmed total; approx 1,046 suspected+confirmed total; Brazil monitoring 2 patients (Sao Paulo + Rio); no confirmed out-of-region case. Suspected+confirmed; no US cases. Brazil monitoring 2 patients plus other designated airports. Entry restrictions for travelers from DRC/Uganda/South Sudan within 21 days remain active. CDC assesses US public risk as low.

WEATHER and WILDFIRE: [SPC](#) Day 1 SLIGHT across two areas today: (1) SE/Lower MS-TN Valleys - active MCS south of STL tracking SE; afternoon re-development AR/TN/MS/AL with MLCAPE approaching 4,000 J/kg; widespread severe wind and hail through evening spreading to central MS/AL. (2) Central High Plains CO/KS: supercells with large to very large hail. TN/Shelbyville and IL/Hillsboro NWR OUT in active corridor. [NIFC](#) reports 18 uncontained large fires; Santa Rosa Island Fire CA 18,379 acres, evacuations in effect. Atlantic hurricane season opened 01-JUN; no active storms.

CYBER: FBI FLASH (26-MAY-2026, TLP:CLEAR): Silent Ransom Group (SRG/Luna Moth) sending physical operatives to US law offices posing as IT support, inserting USB devices to exfiltrate data. 38+ firms hit; 100+ attacks in 2026; no encryption -- attack invisible until ransom demand. Extends to any high-value data sector. Fortinet FortiClient EMS CVE-2026-35616 (CVSS 9.1) under active exploitation;

patch to 7.4.7. FCEB deadlines LiteSpeed CVE-2026-48172 and Daemon Tools CVE-2026-8398 cleared this window; confirm remediation.

SPACE WX: [SWPC](#): brief K4 geomagnetic event 30-MAY (WARK04 Serial 5357, 2035 UTC) within 72h window; resolved. Current Kp (01-JUN): 1.0-1.67, quiet. G-scale not reached; no proton event; no HF blackout. Aurora possible at high latitudes during brief active period. Mid-latitude conditions normal. CHANGE FROM PRIOR: prior cycle had residual K4 lapsed; this cycle new brief K4 in-window, resolved.

MARKETS: AAA national regular: \$4.290/gal as of 01-JUN (down \$0.069/gal week-over-week; +37.5% year-over-year). Diesel: \$5.448; Premium: \$5.187. Brent approx. \$91-92/bbl (-19% May). DJIA ~51,032 (+0.72%); S&P 500 ~7,580 (+0.22%) on ceasefire optimism. [USDA](#) WASDE-671 (12-MAY) remains current; next WASDE 11-JUN.

PRACTITIONER POSTURE - 72-HOUR DECISION TRIGGERS

- 1. FBI FLASH: SRG/Luna Moth physical IT infiltration of US law and high-value data offices** - verify physical access controls and IT vendor social-engineering protocols; Fortinet FortiClient EMS CVE-2026-35616 patch to 7.4.7.
- 2. Iran: Talks suspended 01-JUN then reportedly restored; Trump: deal within one week; Brent \$94.58/bbl** - hold pump-price posture flex; formal signing with Hormuz reopening language is the primary price-decline catalyst.
- 3. SPC SLGT active today: SE corridor (MCS + 4,000 J/kg CAPE in AR/TN/MS/AL) and High Plains supercells (CO/KS)** - TN/Shelbyville and IL/Hillsboro NWR OUT in SE corridor; verify WEA/IPAWS as alternate alert paths.
- 4. Travel and health: Ebola screening expanded to Atlanta + Dulles; entry restrictions in active enforcement** - travelers with DRC/Uganda/South Sudan routing within 21 days must enter through designated airports; 291 confirmed cases (approx 1,046 total suspected+confirmed) (29-MAY); no US cases.

WHAT CHANGED SINCE 01-JUN

+ ADDED: FBI FLASH SRG/Luna Moth physical law firm infiltration advisory (26-MAY). Fortinet CVE-2026-35616 active exploitation confirmed. Ebola: Atlanta screening expanded (23-MAY); Uganda 9 confirmed; approx 1,046 total suspected+confirmed. Russia-Ukraine: Russia mass aerial attack on Kyiv overnight 01-02-JUN; Russia presented memorandum; Ukraine given one week. Active strikes: Kharkiv and Odesa (01-JUN). Hurricane season opened 01-JUN. Santa Rosa Island Fire CA 18,379 acres with evacuations. OFAC shadow fleet sanctions (29-MAY).

~ CHANGED: 72h rollout. Day counters +3: blockade to Day 51; Op Epic Fury to Day 94; WHCD to Day 38. Lebanon CF extension ended 30-MAY (no confirmed renewal). Iran MoU remains unsigned; Brent -19% May; 29 tankers exiting Hormuz; AAA regular \$4.290/gal. Ebola: DRC 282 confirmed + 220 suspected / Uganda 9 confirmed; 291 confirmed total; approx 1,046 suspected+confirmed. WX-CON: Northern Plains supercell SLGT (WY/ND/SD) + FL/GA gusty convections. SWX: new brief K4 (30-MAY) in window, resolved. NWR: 31 transmitters OOS/DEGRADED (02-JUN roster, operator-supplied); 13 AK Juneau cluster; TN/Shelbyville and IL/Hillsboro flagged ACTIVE CORRIDOR. Markets: Brent -19% May; AAA \$4.290/gal.

= NO MATERIAL CHANGE: PREP-CON 3 INCIDENT PROBABLE baseline; COMCON 4 INCIDENT POSSIBLE baseline; WX-CON 2 SLGT level unchanged; US naval blockade operational posture; NIFC 18 uncontained large fires with no FLASH-tier event; no US-impacting seismic event in window.

REMOVED: LiteSpeed CVE-2026-48172 and Daemon Tools CVE-2026-8398 FCEB deadlines cleared during 72h window; confirm remediation. Western Texas SPC SLGT (29-MAY) expired; replaced by SE corridor + High Plains dual-area. Lebanon CF day-counter retired (extension ended 30-MAY). Prior Lebanon ceasefire tensions event now prior context.

KEY JUDGMENTS

Formal analytical conclusions per ICD 203. Each carries a likelihood term and a separate confidence level. These are NOT operational decision triggers (see BLUF above).

KJ-1. Trump formally approving the tentative 60-day Iran MoU within 72 hours is assessed **roughly even chance** at MODERATE confidence (split: HIGH confidence MoU exists on multi-stream corroboration; MODERATE confidence on Trump approval timing given stated deliberation). Full Hormuz reopening within 30 days of signing assessed unlikely at MODERATE confidence (mine clearance, tanker backlog, infrastructure). CHANGE FROM PRIOR: 01-JUN cycle had talks volatile (suspended then reportedly restored same day); Brent surged to \$96 on suspension news, pared to \$94.58 on restoration. Score holds at 25. Responding.

KJ-2. Hormuz effective closure continues through the near term, assessed **very likely** at MODERATE confidence. Blockade Day 51; Iran crude loadings below 0.3M bpd (UBS, May). Hormuz: 4 transits vs 95/day pre-crisis (IMF PortWatch 24-MAY); effectively closed. Even with a signed deal, physical normalization extends to 2027 per Saudi Aramco CEO. Watch for Trump signature, Hormuz mine clearance commencement, and any new kinetic exchange.

KJ-3. Widespread severe events in the SE corridor (AR/TN/MS/AL) this afternoon and evening are assessed **likely** at MODERATE confidence (MLCAPE approaching 4,000 J/kg; active MCS with mesoscale organization). Supercells with large to very large hail in CO/KS High Plains assessed **likely** at MODERATE confidence per sufficient deep-layer shear. CHANGE FROM PRIOR: western Texas SLGT replaced by dual-area SE corridor + High Plains. NWR gap: TN/Shelbyville and IL/Hillsboro OUT in active SE corridor.

KJ-4. Ebola PHEIC outbreak continued growth is assessed **very likely** at HIGH confidence; near-term US imported case assessed **unlikely** at MODERATE confidence. Updated per WHO/ECDC as of 01-JUN: DRC 282 confirmed (42 deaths) + 220 suspected; Uganda 9 confirmed (1 death); 291 confirmed / approx 1,046 total suspected+confirmed / 241+ deaths. Bundibugyo strain: no approved vaccine or specific treatment. CHANGE FROM PRIOR: Uganda cases updated 7 to 9; Atlanta screening added; data revision reduced prior suspected count.

KJ-5. A brief K4 geomagnetic event (01-JUN 1754 UTC, WARK04 Serial 5357) occurred within the 72h reporting window and resolved. Current Kp (01-JUN): 1.0-1.67, quiet-unsettled. G-scale not reached; no proton event; no HF blackout. CHANGE FROM PRIOR: prior cycle carried a residual K4 lapsed before publish; this cycle a new brief K4 in-window resolved. Space weather below FLASH; mid-latitude HF conditions normal.

FLASH EVENTS THIS CYCLE

3 FLASH events at executive summary level. Full SALUTE, alternative hypotheses, and collection gaps are in the DTR Full edition.

Iran Day 51: talks suspended 01-JUN then reportedly restored; Brent \$94.58/bbl volatile; Hormuz 4 transits vs 95/day.

[GEO-001 | UPDATED - MoU UNSIGNED DAY 50; BRENT -19% MAY; 29 TANKERS EXITING HORMUZ]

Current state: Tentative 60-day ceasefire-extension MoU not formally signed as of 01-JUN cycle 01-JUN: Iran suspended talks, reportedly restored same day per regional source. Trump stated deal reachable within one week. Lebanese ceasefire declared 01-JUN (Day 2). Markets moved sharply on deal optimism: Brent -19% in May (worst month since COVID-19 pandemic, approx. \$91-92/bbl); AAA regular \$4.290/gal (+37.5% year-over-year). Hormuz: 4 transits vs 95/day pre-crisis (IMF PortWatch 24-MAY); effectively closed. CENTCOM providing navigational guidance. 29-MAY shadow fleet sanctions targeting Hong Kong-linked entities assisting Iran military petroleum exports. Blockade Day 51.

CHANGE FROM PRIOR: CHANGE FROM PRIOR: 29-MAY cycle had MoU tentative and unsigned; Lebanon ceasefire tensions event was new; deal optimism just emerging. This cycle the MoU remains unsigned after 72h but market and physical shipping response is accelerating: Brent -19% May, 29 tankers exiting. Lebanon ceasefire tensions event is now prior context.

Downstream: MoU formal approval assessed **roughly even chance** at MODERATE confidence. Full Hormuz reopening within 30 days of signing assessed **unlikely** at MODERATE confidence. Even signed deal: physical normalization slow (mines, infrastructure, tanker backlog). A formal signing with clear Hormuz timeline would accelerate retail fuel decline; analysts estimate 3-5 cents/gal within 5-7 days. A breakdown back to conflict: 8-15 cents/gal spike within 3-5 days.

Ebola PHEIC: 291 confirmed (DRC 282 + Uganda 9) as of 01-JUN; approx 1,046 total; Brazil monitoring 2 patients; Atlanta screening active.

Current state: Updated per WHO/ECDC 01-JUN: DRC 282 confirmed (42 deaths) + 220 suspected across Ituri, North Kivu, South Kivu; Uganda 9 confirmed (1 death, Kampala). Total: 291 confirmed (approx 1,046 total suspected+confirmed) / 241+ deaths. Bundibugyo strain has no approved vaccine or specific treatment (existing treatments for Zaire strain). No US cases. Screening expanded to Atlanta (23-MAY) plus Dulles and other designated airports. Entry restrictions active for travelers from DRC/Uganda/South Sudan within 21 days. CDC: domestic risk low.

CHANGE FROM PRIOR: CHANGE FROM PRIOR: DRC confirmed count rose from ~125 (two weeks prior) to 282 as of 01-JUN per WHO/ECDC; Uganda rose 7 to 9; Brazil monitoring 2 patients is new development - first potential out-of-region signal. DRC at 125 / 282 DRC confirmed + 9 Uganda confirmed = 291 confirmed total as of 01-JUN. Approx 1,046 total suspected+confirmed. Brazil monitoring 2 patients. Atlanta screening active.

Downstream: Continued case growth assessed **very likely** at HIGH confidence. Near-term US imported case assessed **unlikely** at MODERATE confidence. Travelers with DRC/Uganda/South Sudan routing must enter through designated airports. Risk amplifiers: eastern DRC conflict/displacement, mining population movement, cross-border travel.

SPC SLGT: SE corridor active MCS; High Plains supercell hail today.

[WX-001 | UPDATED - DUAL-AREA SLGT: SE CORRIDOR MCS + HIGH PLAINS SUPERCELLS]

Current state: [SPC](#) Day 1 SLIGHT across two areas. (1) SE/Lower MS-TN Valleys: active MCS south of STL tracking SE into KY/TN/GA; 30+ kt mid-level flow; damaging wind gusts primary MCS threat; afternoon re-development AR/TN/MS/AL with MLCAPE approaching 4,000 J/kg, widespread severe wind and hail through evening, spreading to central MS/AL. (2) Central High Plains (CO/KS/WY/NE panhandle/SW SD): supercells capable of large to very large hail; bowing clusters with wind gusts as LLJ strengthens tonight. NWR gap in SE corridor: TN/Shelbyville and IL/Hillsboro both OUT. Wildfire: Santa Rosa Island Fire CA 18,379 acres with evacuations; 18 uncontained nationwide.

CHANGE FROM PRIOR: CHANGE FROM PRIOR: western Texas SPC SLGT replaced by dual-area SE corridor + High Plains. SE corridor is the higher-impact area (4,000 J/kg CAPE, active MCS). NWR gap shifts from TX corridor to TN/IL in active threat area. Hurricane season opened 01-JUN; no active storms.

Downstream: SE corridor widespread severe storms assessed **likely** at MODERATE confidence. High Plains supercell hail assessed **likely** at MODERATE confidence. Residents in TN, KY, AR, MS, AL, CO, KS: verify WEA and IPAWS as alternate paths where NWR is OOS.

PREP-CON 3 - INCIDENT PROBABLE (Brown Sky) | Trend: STABLE

COMCON 4 - INCIDENT POSSIBLE: 29 [NWR](#) transmitters affected (17 OUT OF SERVICE + 12 DEGRADED) across 15 states per the 01-JUN operator roster (1143 UTC). Most operationally relevant: TN/Shelbyville (OUT) and IL/Hillsboro (OUT) in the active SPC SLIGHT SE severe weather corridor today; MD/Baltimore (OUT) new this cycle; 11-site AK Juneau cluster DEGRADED. NM gap at Carlsbad/Artesia/Roswell persists; no SPC threat there today.

WX-CON 2 - SLGT: SPC Day 1 SLIGHT (NOAA tier 2 of 5) across portions of western Texas, with sporadic large hail and severe winds gusting upwards of 75 mph, plus a Colorado Plateau and Southwest critical fire-weather threat. CHANGE FROM PRIOR: the 28-MAY cycle placed the SLIGHT risk over the interior Pacific Northwest; this cycle the convective focus has shifted south to western Texas.

SWX-CON 1 - Minor: SWPC WARK04 Serial 5357 (30-MAY 2036 UTC): brief K4 active event in 72h window, resolved. Current Kp (01-JUN): 1.0-1.67, quiet. G-scale not reached; no proton event; no HF blackout. CHANGE FROM PRIOR: prior cycle had residual K4 lapsed before publish; this cycle new brief K4 in-window, resolved. Scale per [NOAA Space Weather Scales](#).

- ▶ Iran Day 51: talks suspended 01-JUN then reportedly restored (Trump: deal within one week); Lebanon ceasefire Day 2; Brent \$94.58/bbl volatile; AAA regular \$4.290/gal; Hormuz: 4 transits vs 95/day (effectively closed); MARAD 2026-004 active; physical normalization slow even if signed.
- ▶ Ebola PHEIC (Bundibugyo strain); 291 confirmed cases (approx 1,046 total suspected+confirmed; 291 confirmed as of 01-JUN; DRC 282/Uganda 9; Brazil monitoring 2 patients; no US cases; Atlanta + Dulles screening active; no approved vaccine.
- ▶ SPC SLGT dual-area today: SE corridor MCS + 4,000 J/kg CAPE (AR/TN/MS/AL evening); High Plains supercells CO/KS; TN/Shelbyville and IL/Hillsboro NWR OUT in active SE corridor; FBI FLASH SRG physical law firm infiltration.
- ▶ Space weather: brief K4 30-MAY in window, resolved; Kp 1.0-1.67 quiet 01-JUN; Lebanon CF extension ended 30-MAY, no confirmed renewal; hurricane season opened 01-JUN, no active storms.
- ▶ Russia-Ukraine: second Istanbul round 02-JUN, memoranda exchanged; active strikes Kharkiv and Odesa 01-JUN; NIFC 18 uncontained fires; Santa Rosa Island CA 18,379 acres evacuations; Fortinet CVE-2026-35616 active exploitation.
