IRAN/HORMUZ DAY 52 - ACTIVE KINETICS, TALKS IN DISPUTED STATUS:

Iran state media: mediator comms suspended several days; Tehran conditioning return on Lebanon ceasefire enforcement. Active kinetics 02-03-JUN: [IRGC](#) missiles at Kuwait/Bahrain (intercepted); US Qeshm Island strike; US tanker M/T Lexie hit; Iranian drones hit Kuwait airport 03-JUN (1 killed). Trump and Rubio publicly dispute suspension. Rubio: Iran agreed to negotiate nuclear aspects for first time. No MOU signed. Brent \$96.89 (+0.93%, 3rd consecutive gain). [\[GEO-001\]](#)

RUSSIA MASS AERIAL ATTACK 02-JUN - US JUNE DEADLINE NOW

PASSED: 73 missiles + 656 drones overnight 01-02-JUN. 22 civilians killed, 138 wounded across Kyiv, Dnipro, Poltava, Kharkiv, Zaporizhzhia. Children among the dead. US-set June peace deadline has arrived with talks stalled since February 2026 Geneva round. [\[GEO-002\]](#)

EBOLA PHEIC - REVISED COUNT DOWN; BRAZIL CLEARED: [WHO/ECDC](#) revised DRC count to 321 confirmed (48 deaths) + 116 suspected; Uganda 15 confirmed (1 death). Brazil both patients **NEGATIVE** as of 01-JUN. PHEIC remains in force. No approved Bundibugyo vaccine. MSF: response has not caught up to the epidemic. [\[HLTH-001\]](#)

SEVERE WX - N PLAINS SLIGHT; THREE R2 SOLAR EVENTS: [SPC](#) Day 1 SLIGHT: N NE / E Dakotas / W MN supercell threat this afternoon - large hail primary, severe winds by evening, tornadoes possible (low confidence). [SWPC](#): three R2 (Moderate) events today (M9.3 0136Z + M7.7 0700Z + ongoing M5+). HF blackout risk on sunlit paths. Kp max 3; no G-scale storm.

PRACTITIONER POSTURE - 72-HOUR DECISION TRIGGERS

1. Iran: **Watch for MOU signing or kinetics escalation. Kuwait airport hit 03-JUN moves theater from interdiction to civil infrastructure targeting.** Prepare for Brent continuation toward \$100 if no deal this week.
2. Cyber: **FCEB deadline TODAY - Microsoft Defender patches must be confirmed.** FortiClient EMS exploitation ongoing - check exposure before EOD.
3. Weather: **N Plains severe wx active this afternoon through evening.** Check [NWR](#) status - 32 transmitters affected; Angola IN (KX194) now OOS in Northern Indiana.
4. Ebola: **Brazil cleared. DRC/Uganda case counts revised down.** PHEIC remains in force; screen any staff with DRC/Uganda/South Sudan exposure within 21 days.

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KEY JUDGMENTS

KJ-1 IRAN/HORMUZ: Iran will not sign a formal MOU this week without Lebanon ceasefire enforcement as a precondition. Mediation suspension announced by Iranian state media reflects deliberate leverage; Trump/Rubio dispute creates ambiguity. Active kinetics 02-03-JUN (Kuwait airport) signal Iran is escalating pressure while negotiating.

LIKELIHOOD: Likely. **CONFIDENCE:** MODERATE.

CHANGE FROM PRIOR: Prior cycle assessed talks as tentative but progressing. This cycle: mediator comms suspended, Kuwait airport hit, Lebanon blocking condition hardened. Assessment moves from cautious progress to probable stall.

KJ-2 RUSSIA/UKRAINE: Russia will continue mass aerial campaigns against Ukrainian civilian and energy infrastructure through the summer. The US June peace deadline has no enforcement mechanism; Zelensky will not accept terms without security guarantees. Talks remain stalled at February 2026 Geneva baseline.

LIKELIHOOD: Very likely. **CONFIDENCE:** HIGH.

KJ-3 EBOLA: Ebola outbreak will remain contained to DRC and Uganda for the next 30 days. Brazil clearance reduces out-of-continent spread risk. The revised case count (down from ~1,000 suspected to 321 confirmed) reflects [WHO/ECDC](#) reclassification, not outbreak contraction. MSF assessment that response has not caught up to the epidemic is the primary concern.

LIKELIHOOD: Likely. **CONFIDENCE:** MODERATE.

Iran Day 52: [IRGC](#) strikes Kuwait/Bahrain (intercepted); US Qeshm strike; Kuwait airport drone hit 03-JUN; talks in disputed status. Brent \$96.89.

Blockade Day 52. No MOU signed. Iran state media: mediator comms suspended several days; Tehran conditioning return on Lebanon ceasefire enforcement. Active kinetics 02-03-JUN: [IRGC](#) ballistic missiles at Kuwait and Bahrain (intercepted); US struck Qeshm Island military ground control; US struck tanker M/T Lexie engine room near Kharg Island; Iranian drones hit Kuwait airport 03-JUN (1 killed, dozens wounded; airport briefly shut). Trump and Rubio publicly dispute suspension. Rubio: Iran agreed to discuss nuclear program for first time. Brent \$96.89 (+0.93%, 3rd consecutive session gain). [AAA](#) \$4.290/gal confirmed live 03-JUN.

***CHANGE FROM PRIOR:** 02-JUN cycle had active kinetics beginning ([IRGC](#) missiles). This cycle: Kuwait airport hit, mediator suspension announced, Lebanon blocking condition hardened. Escalation continues.*

DOWNSTREAM: Brent continuation toward \$100 if no deal this week; Kuwait airport hit may trigger additional Gulf state alignment action; Lebanon blocking issue links Iran track to Sec 4B LBN entry.

Russia mass aerial attack Kyiv 02-JUN: 73 missiles + 656 drones; 22 killed, 138 wounded. US June peace deadline now reached.

FLASH | NEW THIS CYCLE | 22

Russia launched the largest recent mass aerial campaign overnight 01-02-JUN: 73 missiles + 656 drones targeting Kyiv, Dnipro, Poltava, Kharkiv, and Zaporizhzhia. 22 civilians killed, 138 wounded; children among the dead. Ukrainian AD destroyed 40 missiles and 602 drones. US-set June peace deadline has now arrived with talks stalled since the February 2026 Geneva round. Zelensky: window open until winter 2026. Rubio admitted talks stalled 12-MAY.

[WHO Ebola PHEIC](#): DRC 321 confirmed (48 deaths); Uganda 15 confirmed; Brazil both patients NEGATIVE 01-JUN.

FLASH | UPDATED | 22

[WHO/ECDC](#) revised DRC count to 321 confirmed (48 deaths) + 116 suspected; Uganda 15 confirmed (1 death). Brazil: both patients (Sao Paulo + Rio) tested NEGATIVE for Ebola as of 01-JUN. PHEIC in force. No approved Bundibugyo vaccine. MSF building 65-bed ETC in Ituri. CEPI fast-tracking 3 vaccine candidates (IAVI \$3.2M, Moderna \$50M, Oxford \$8.6M). [CDC](#) risk: LOW for US public.

CHANGE FROM PRIOR: Case count revised DOWN from ~1,046 total suspected+confirmed to 321 confirmed DRC + 15 Uganda. Brazil patients cleared. Outbreak not growing as fast as prior counts suggested, but MSF says response still behind.

[SWPC](#): Three R2 events 03-JUN (M9.3 0136Z, M7.7 0700Z, ongoing M5+ 1141Z); HF blackout risk sunlit paths; Kp max 3.

FLASH | THREE R2 EVENTS | 14

Three separate R2 (Moderate) X-ray events 03-JUN from active region near disk center. M9.3 (0122-0143Z) + M7.7 (0648-0707Z) both produced Type II radio sweeps indicating CME association possible. Third event ongoing at 1141Z (Serial 531). Geomagnetic: Kp max 3; no G-scale storm reached. HF radio blackout risk on sunlit paths; GPS precision minor impact possible. HF operators: expect periodic blackout windows on sunlit paths during flare events. CME analysis pending from [SWPC](#).

ANALYTICAL STANDARDS

FFTP Intelligence Operations Division follows ICD 203 (Analytic Standards) and ICD 206 (Sourcing) for all scored entries. Every FLASH and HIGH entry carries: (1) likelihood band from the §0.55 estimative ladder, (2) confidence level (HIGH/MODERATE/LOW), and (3) minimum two alternative hypotheses with supporting and disconfirming evidence.

TIER DEFINITIONS

T1: Primary government, academic, or institutional sources with direct reporting capability. **T2**: Established news organizations with editorial standards and regional expertise. **T3**: Specialized or emerging sources used with explicit framing caveats.
