Prepare for Brent movement on announcement (deal: downside toward \$89/bbl; collapse: spike toward \$100+). Lebanon CF rejection is the primary complicating factor.</p> <p>2. Cyber: World Cup opens Jun 11 (3 days). Activate elevated monitoring for FIFA-related phishing, credential stuffing, and ICS/OT probing. Iranian APT campaign against US water/energy/govt PLCs is active with confirmed victim disruptions. CISA institutional capacity reduced - do not rely on agency response time.</p> <p>3. Weather: SPC Slight Risk TODAY in CO/KS - peak 1400-2200 local. 31 NWR transmitters OOS/DEGRADED. KS Ulysses WXN81 OOS in threat zone. G3 storm active TODAY compounds HF communications. KEY JUDGMENTS
<p>KJ-1 IRAN/HORMUZ: Ceasefire talks at critical juncture but deal "largely negotiated" per Trump 09-JUN. Iran's 06-JUN drone + missile launches are the most significant new kinetics this cycle. Hezbollah rejection of Lebanon CF framework is the primary complicating factor - it gives Iran a pretext to block Hormuz MOU talks. No MOU signing expected this cycle regardless of Trump optimism. WTI \$91.68/bbl on ceasefire durability concerns. CSIS notes munitions window vulnerability.</p> <p>LIKELIHOOD: roughly even chance (deal announcement within 72 hours). CONFIDENCE: MODERATE.</p> <p><i>CHANGE FROM PRIOR:</i> Prior cycle assessed talks progressing cautiously. This cycle: Iran fired missiles and drones, US struck radar sites, Lebanon blocking condition hardened. Assessment: cautious progress to critical juncture.</p>
<p>KJ-2 RUSSIA/UKRAINE: Russia will continue escalatory targeting of Ukrainian and now nuclear-adjacent infrastructure. The Russian drone strike on Chornobyl CSFSF represents a new operational threshold - targeting of spent nuclear fuel storage. The US June peace deadline has passed with no agreement. Zelenskyy's direct talks offer was rejected by Putin. Expect continued Russian infrastructure strikes through summer with periodic nuclear-adjacent escalation for signaling purposes.</p> <p>LIKELIHOOD: very likely. CONFIDENCE: HIGH.</p> <p><i>CHANGE FROM PRIOR:</i> Prior cycle: Crimea gasoline shortages reported. Current: shortages advancing to basic goods beyond gasoline; Chornobyl CSFSF strike new; peace talks formally rejected.</p>
<p>KJ-3 EBOLA/PUBLIC HEALTH: Ebola PHEIC trajectory remains active with 378 confirmed cases and 88 deaths. Bundibugyo virus has no approved vaccine or treatment - this is operationally distinct from prior DRC Zaire ebolavirus outbreaks. ADF and</p>

M23/AFC armed conflict in Ituri/N.Kivu remains the primary analytical driver of response failure - security conditions limit aid movement and health facility access. World Cup Jun 11 opens: DRC/Uganda not participating but monitor for case export to US host cities.

LIKELIHOOD: likely (sustained PHEIC trajectory). **CONFIDENCE:** MODERATE.

CHANGE FROM PRIOR: Prior cycle: DRC 363 confirmed / 62 deaths. Current: 378 confirmed / 88 deaths (+15 new, +26 deaths). Trajectory: sustained ACCELERATING pace.

DHL CEO: 4-6 months to normalize shipping after deal.

CHANGE FROM PRIOR: 05-JUN cycle: Iran warning shots at US warships, CENTCOM intercept M/T DAVINA. This cycle: Iran fired ballistic missiles toward Gulf states; US struck Iranian territory; Kuwait airport hit; Trump deal signal. Escalation level elevated.

LIKELIHOOD: roughly even chance (Hormuz deal within 72 hours). **CONFIDENCE:** MODERATE. If deal signed: Brent downside toward \$89/bbl Q4. If talks collapse: spike toward \$100+. Alt-Hyp 1 (unlikely): MOU signed this week; Hormuz begins reopening within 30 days. Alt-Hyp 2 (roughly even chance): talks collapse, ceasefire fractures, kinetic escalation resumes.

Philippines M7.8 - 07-JUN 23:37 UTC. 32+ KIA / 200+ injured. 1-meter tsunami. General Santos.

FLASH | NEW | 22

PHS-001 - M7.8 struck 26 km SW of Kablalan, Mindanao (depth 55.2 km) at 07-JUN 23:37 UTC. 32+ killed, 200+ injured. 1-meter tsunami hit Sultan Kudarat and Sarangani coasts. Buildings collapsed in General Santos (722,000 pop.). Aftershock M6.5 at 00:55 UTC 09-JUN; active sequence continuing. 7M+ felt strong shaking. USGS PAGER Orange economic alert (significant damage; regional/national response likely needed). 3.2M students and 128K teachers displaced on first day of school. Pacific Tsunami Warning Center cleared tsunami threat ~5 hrs post-event. Japan issued/lifted Okinawa advisory. Red Cross, NDRRMC, Office of Civil Defense responding.

LIKELIHOOD: likely (death toll exceeds 50). **CONFIDENCE:** MODERATE. Alt-Hyp 1 (roughly even chance): toll stabilizes 40-75 with effective response. Alt-Hyp 2 (unlikely): exceeds 100 with widespread infrastructure failure.

Russia struck Chornobyl spent fuel storage 07-JUN. Fire out. Radiation stable. IAEA Board convenes 09-JUN.

NUC-001 - Russian drone struck the Centralized Spent Nuclear Fuel Storage Facility (CSFSF) approximately 15 km from Chornobyl NPP 07-JUN. Fuel-reception building significantly damaged. Fire ignited, extinguished ~1 hour. Radiation monitoring: no spike beyond safe levels. IAEA chief Rafael Grossi: "deeply concerning" - large amounts of nuclear material at facility. IAEA Board of Governors convened Vienna 09-JUN; inspection team deploying. Russia has not publicly commented. Zelenskyy: "nuclear terrorism." Zelenskyy proposed direct talks with Putin 07-JUN via open letter; Putin declined. Second nuclear-adjacent Chornobyl strike of 2026 (February: containment arch). Action-reaction: Ukraine struck St. Petersburg and Kursk 06-07-JUN preceding the Chornobyl strike.

LIKELIHOOD: likely (additional nuclear-adjacent infrastructure targeting by Russia in next 14 days). **CONFIDENCE:** MODERATE. **LIKELIHOOD:** very unlikely (radiation release from Chornobyl-area facilities). **CONFIDENCE:** HIGH. Alt-Hyp 1 (likely): deliberate nuclear signaling. Alt-Hyp 2 (less likely): opportunistic/navigation error.

ANALYTICAL STANDARDS & SOURCE REGISTRY

ANALYTICAL STANDARDS

FFTP Intelligence Operations Division follows ICD 203 (Analytic Standards) and ICD 206 (Sourcing Requirements) for all scored entries. Every FLASH and HIGH entry carries: (1) likelihood band from the \$0.55 estimative ladder, (2) confidence level (HIGH/MODERATE/LOW), and (3) minimum two alternative hypotheses with supporting and disconfirming evidence.

TIER DEFINITIONS

T1: Primary government, academic, or institutional sources with direct reporting capability. T2: Established news organizations with editorial standards and regional expertise. T3: Specialized or emerging sources - used with explicit framing caveats.
