LIKELIHOOD: CVE-2026-20262 exploitation leads to SD-WAN management environment breach before 29-JUN patching deadline: LIKELY given active exploitation and 5-day window. CONFIDENCE: MODERATE. Enterprise pivot from SD-WAN Manager to branch edge devices in compromised environment: LIKELY if initial access achieved. CONFIDENCE: HIGH.
