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⚠️ PREPAREDNESS CONDITION 3 - BROWN SKY ⚠️

World Cup Round of 32 concluding 03-JUL / Round of 16 begins 04-JUL, now converging with the America250 (July 4th) weekend - a real fan-zone violence pattern has developed at San Jose's San Pedro Square (see STSB-003). Al-Saadi KH/HAYI: NSTR, still awaiting 09-SEP trial date. NTAS: no current advisory as of this brief.

SEASONAL: FIFA WORLD CUP R32 CONCLUDING / R16 BEGINS 04-JUL - AMERICA250 CONVERGENCE

FIFA World Cup Round of 32 concludes 03-JUL; Round of 16 begins 04-JUL. 16 host cities across the US, Canada, and Mexico active through 19-JUL. The tournament now converges directly with the America250 (July 4th) Semiquincentennial weekend, with World Cup matches in Houston and Philadelphia landing on July 4th itself.

STANDING POSTURE - HOUSES OF WORSHIP / JEWISH INSTITUTIONS

The following mitigations remain in force from prior cycles regardless of whether a specific credible threat is identified this week:

- Vehicle standoff at all entrances - bollards, planters, or law-enforcement presence at drop-off points. A vehicle is the lowest-skill, highest-lethality tool available to a solo attacker.
- Child-area and youth-program access control - sign-in procedures, adult escort requirements, and staff-to-child ratios enforced at all times. The Al-Saadi indictment language included Jewish "schools" as a target category.
- HVAC intake audit - air intake locations mapped and access controlled. UK institutional hardening toward chemical-exposure kits signals UK CT assessment treats this vector as plausible.
- Mail and package intake protocol - all incoming packages screened before entering the interior. Train staff to identify IED precursor characteristics.
- FBI JTTF liaison - if your synagogue or JCC does not have an established FBI field office liaison, establish it now. Commissioner Tisch's statement that she has not seen a threat environment like this in 18 years of government was made at a synagogue security briefing - that briefing pipeline exists; access it.
- Nonprofit Security Grant Program (NSGP) FY2026 - ADL secured a \$30M increase in NSGP funding for FY2026. Apply if you have not already done so. Funding covers physical security hardening, cameras, access control, and training.

BOTTOM LINE UP FRONT

Three things define your security calculus this cycle:

1. Al-Saadi/KH-HAYI case: NSTR on new court developments. No new hearing or filing identified since the 02-JUN arraignment; the case remains on track for the 09-SEP-2026 trial date.

2. San Jose's San Pedro Square fan zone: homicide (28-JUN, unconnected to any match) and stabbings/unlawful assembly (30-JUN, Mexico win, 40,000+ crowd). RSVP now mandatory for Round of 32 watch parties -- and it held at its first test (01-JUL, USA vs Bosnia, no incidents). Separately, converges with America250: foiled White House UFC plot (7 charged), first-ever NSSE at the National Mall, and World Cup matches in Houston/Philadelphia on July 4th itself. DHS has assigned all 78 World Cup matches SEAR Level 1 or 2 -- a 240% increase in similarly-rated events versus a standard year. See STSB-003.

3. The antisemitic-incident baseline remains unchanged from last cycle -- no newer ADL annual audit exists than the 06-MAY-2026 release. One new unclaimed incident: 02-JUN Golders Green stairwell arson (UK, no arrest). See STSB-002. Note: no current NTAS advisory is in force, confirmed directly against DHS's own page -- its absence should not be read as a green indicator.

WHY THIS CYCLE

Carried at **BACKGROUND** tier rather than dropped because the 09-SEP trial date is a live calendar tripwire and the network's distributed European cells remain active and unresolved.

SUMMARY

One named senior Kata'ib Hizballah commander (Al-Saadi) remains in SDNY custody on an 8-count indictment covering a disrupted plot against a Manhattan synagogue plus Jewish centers in LA and Scottsdale, and roughly 20 attacks across Europe/Canada. Case status, custody posture, and the 09-SEP trial date are all unchanged from Issue 9 (12-JUN).

SALUTE

SIZE: One named senior KH commander (Al-Saadi) in federal custody, SDNY. Plot scope: simultaneous attacks on a Manhattan synagogue plus Jewish centers in Los Angeles and Scottsdale AZ. Network scope: 20-plus attacks across Europe and Canada. Parent FTO Kata'ib Hizballah: 7,000-10,000 members.

ACTIVITY: NSTR this cycle. For record: 02-JUN arraignment, NOT GUILTY plea, 8-count indictment superseding the original 6-count complaint, defense mounting a political-prisoner/POW framing, prosecutors warning the case may widen.

LOCATION: Manhattan federal court (SDNY). Metropolitan Detention Center, Brooklyn -- defendant held without bail. Collateral at-large cells: Amsterdam, Paris, London, Skopje.

TIME: Next court date: 09-SEP-2026, unchanged. No new date reporting identified this window.

EQUIPMENT: No change. Prior-cycle detail (crypto down payment, seized electronic devices) stands as the operative record.

UNIT: FBI New York JTTF; SDNY prosecutors (Jay Clayton); NYPD; DOJ National Security Division. Defense: Andrew Dalack.

Analyst Assessment

NO CHANGE: case status, custody posture, and next court date all unchanged from Issue 9. No new HAYI claim against a US target identified in open source this cycle.

LIKELIHOOD: A further KH/HAYI-linked attempt against a US Jewish or pro-Israel soft target over the next 60 days: **ROUGHLY EVEN CHANCE**. **CONFIDENCE: MODERATE**.

Unchanged from prior cycle -- network demonstrated intent, funding, and sustained European tempo; the disrupted US cell does not by itself indicate the broader network has stood down.

CHANGE FROM PRIOR: PRIOR (Issue 9, 12-JUN): arraignment complete, 8-count indictment, September 9 next date. CURRENT (Issue 10, 02-JUL): no case movement identified; likelihood judgment unchanged.

TRIPWIRES: (1) Any new HAYI claim or KH-attributed attack; (2) identification of a second US-based cell; (3) a change in Al-Saadi custody posture; (4) an Iranian state statement endorsing retaliation; (5) 09-SEP court date developments; (6) any network response timed to the World Cup or July 4th window.

COLLECTION GAPS: Identity/location of US-based cells beyond Al-Saadi; whether Al-Saadi has cooperated with FBI; current HAYI operational leadership succession -- none established in open source.

WHY THIS CYCLE	Carried at BACKGROUND tier because no new CLAIMED HAYI attack was identified in open source this window -- a genuine change from the near-weekly cadence of prior cycles.	
SUMMARY	UK national threat level remains SEVERE. After a near-continuous claimed-attack cadence since March, this is the first cycle with no new claimed HAYI attack -- likelihood downgraded from VERY LIKELY/HIGH to LIKELY/MODERATE, flagged as tentative given a three-week research gap. A 02-JUN Golders Green stairwell arson (unclaimed, no arrest) and a Dutch court update on the Rotterdam firebombing case are the only new developments.	
SALUTE	SIZE: UK national threat level: SEVERE, unchanged. Active arson-linked sites: Golders Green, Finchley, Kenton, Tower Hamlets, Whitechapel. ACTIVITY: NSTR on a new CLAIMED attack. Unclaimed: 02-JUN, Golders Green -- an empty pram deliberately set alight in a majority-Jewish apartment building's stairwell; residents extinguished it themselves; no arrest, Met Police motive undetermined. WHY THIS CYCLE	San Jose's new RSVP/crowd-management policy held cleanly at its first real test (01-JUL, tens of thousands attending, no incidents). This is the highest-magnitude change since the prior issue.	
SUMMARY	A real violence pattern at San Pedro Square (homicide 28-JUN, stabbings/unlawful assembly 30-JUN) prompted San Jose's mayor to impose mandatory RSVP for Round of 32 watch parties. The very next major watch party (01-JUL, USA vs Bosnia) drew tens of thousands with no incidents reported. Separately, this converges with America250: a foiled White House UFC plot, a first-ever NSSE designation for the National Mall fireworks, and World Cup matches landing in Houston and Philadelphia on July 4th itself.	
SALUTE	SIZE: Round of 32 concludes 03-JUL; Round of 16 begins 04-JUL. 16 host cities remain active through the 19-JUL final. San Pedro Square: two incidents in three days, then one clean night under new controls. America250: NSSE-designated National Mall fireworks, 1M+ expected spectators, 5,000 National Guard. ACTIVITY: SAN PEDRO SQUARE: 28-JUN (Sun) -- shooting adjacent to the venue, one dead, one critically injured, no match in progress, motive unknown. 30-JUN (Tue) -- following Mexico's win (tens of thousands), celebrations turned disorderly: two stabbings, two dispersal orders, pepper spray, bottles thrown at officers, multiple arrests. Highest-risk zones nationally are identified as peripheral gathering points -- fan-fest zones, waterfronts, pedestrian bridges, transit stops, rideshare queues, adjacent parking -- which lack access control and are assessed as target-rich for vehicle-ramming or small-arms attacks by a lone offender. LOCATION: San Jose (San Pedro Square, primary concern, trending positive under new controls); San Francisco (Mission Bay, secondary/unconnected); Washington DC (National Mall, NSSE); Philadelphia (city of concern); Houston and Philadelphia (July 4th match hosts). CONTEXTUAL BASELINE - ANTISEMITIC THREAT ENVIRONMENT

ADL 2025 Audit of Antisemitic Incidents - Released 06-MAY-2026

This audit was released after the prior STSB issue and constitutes the current operative baseline for the standing synagogue, JCC, and Jewish-institution threat picture. Key findings:

- 6,274 total antisemitic incidents in 2025 - average 17 per day. 33% decrease from 2024 but the third-highest year since ADL began tracking in 1979; five times higher than a decade ago.
- 203 physical assaults - the highest assault count ADL has ever recorded. Up 4% from 2024.
- 32 assaults involving a deadly weapon - up 39% from 23 in 2024.
- Three people killed in antisemitic attacks in 2025 - first antisemitic murder year since 2019. Incidents: Capital Jewish Museum shooting DC (two Israeli Embassy staffers), Boulder CO Molotov attack (Run for Their Lives event, one killed), Pennsylvania Governor Shapiro residence firebombing.
- 1,129 antisemitic incidents targeted Jewish institutions specifically in 2025.
- ADL secured a \$30M increase in federal Nonprofit Security Grant Program (NSGP) funding for FY2026. Jewish institutions that have not applied for NSGP funding should do so.
- Companion legislation: Jewish American Security Act introduced in Senate (Senators Rosen and Lankford) 19-MAY-2026. Monitor for Congressional action.

NTAS STATUS NOTE: No current NTAS advisory is in force. The NTAS website has been under-managed since a February 2026 funding lapse per HSToday reporting. The June 22, 2025 bulletin (Iran conflict / heightened threat environment, expires September 22, 2025) is the last advisory in the public record. The absence of an NTAS advisory does not indicate the threat environment has normalized; it indicates the public-facing advisory system has not been updated in the current conflict environment. Operators should not use NTAS silence as a green indicator.

- Through 19 JUL 2026: FIFA World Cup in progress. R32 concludes 03-JUL; R16 begins 04-JUL. Soft targets outside stadiums remain the standing exposure for the duration.
- 19 JUL 2026: World Cup Final, MetLife Stadium, NY/NJ. Highest symbolic value target of the summer.
- 09 SEP 2026: Al-Saadi next court date, SDNY. Monitor for any network response timed to this date.
- 04 JUL 2026: America250 National Mall fireworks (NSSE); World Cup matches in Houston and Philadelphia; the highest single-day convergence of this brief's tracked threads.

ANALYTICAL STANDARDS & SOURCING

This product is produced in conformance with ICD 203 (Analytic Standards) and ICD 206 (Sourcing Requirements). Likelihood and confidence are stated as separate dimensions on every forward-looking judgment. Likelihood uses the estimative ladder (almost no chance, very unlikely, unlikely, roughly even chance, likely, very likely, almost certain); confidence is HIGH, MODERATE, or LOW. Every scored entry carries a minimum of two alternative hypotheses with supporting and disconfirming evidence.
